Are You Race Day Ready To #Runcymru?

Please make sure you're in the best possible shape to tackle the challenge ahead, whether you are running the full marathon which is run over 26.2 miles (42km) or the half marathon which is run over 13.1 miles (21km).

You should stand on the Start Line feeling confident you can run 10 miles (for the half marathon runners) or 20 miles (for the full marathon runners) without stopping. We don't want anyone to struggle to get to the Finish Line and we want you to enjoy every step of the race!

The Race Village will be situated in Festival Fields (SA15 4DP) adjacent to the Start/Finish Area. Within the Race Village you will find the Information Point, pre/post-race massage, catering and toilets.

Bag Drop


Owen's Logistics trailer, Festival Fields Car Park (SA15 4DP). You can deposit a single bag at the bag drop. Please only bring a bag if absolutely necessary. Please DO NOT bring, store or leave valuable items in your bag – the organisers, partners, staff, volunteers or anyone working at the Event will NOT be responsible for loss, damage or theft of personal items.

All bags should be adequately secured. Please use the numbered label in your race pack, placing it around the handle of your bag for easy identification.

There'll be increased security and bag checks in place on Race Day.






Getting Here By Car

The race takes place at Festival Fields, Llanelli. The main access route to Llanelli is via the M4 using Junction 48. You can also use the A484 and head towards the A484 just off Sandy Water Park, the access to Festival Fields is right next to the Days Garage and the postcode is SA15 4DP. If you're travelling by car, we'd suggest that you arrive early to secure your parking space.

There is no charge for parking.



Your Race Number (bib)

The Great Welsh Full and Half Marathon are timed events, using a timing chip which is attached to the back of your bib.

Please make sure your bib is secured to the **FRONT** of your vest/t-shirt. **DO NOT** cut/fold or in any way modify your race number. During the race, your bib is your identification. If you are not correctly displaying your race number at all times you will be disqualified and maybe removed from the course.

Your timing chip will activate as you cross the start line so please don't worry if others start ahead of you.

You must wear your race bib, without it you will not get your finish time and you will be asked to leave the course. If you lose or misplace your bib there'll be a limited number of spares available at the Information Point in the Race Village at Festival Fields. It'll cost you £10 (cash only) for a replacement bib, so please remember to bring yours with you!

IMPORTANT - YOU MUST NEVER WEAR SOMEONE ELSE'S BIB.

YOU MUST COMPLETE THE MEDICAL INFORMATION ON THE BACK OF THE BIB.

Great Welsh Full Marathon bibs will have a gold middle section. Great Welsh Half Marathon bibs will have a red middle section.

Please note, the Half Marathon will start at 09:00 and the Full Marathon will start at 09:15.

Race Day Registrations

You can't enter on Race Day. If you entered the race after 11th March 2019 you'll need to collect your race bib from the Information Point in the Race Village at Festival Fields.





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If you have a medical condition please make sure it is included on the back of your bib in the medical information section and put a **red 'X'** on the front of your bib.

If since registering you have received a diagnosis for a medical condition, please inform St John Cymru Wales Medical Team on Race Day. If at any time during the race you feel unable to continue, **please stop, rest and locate** the nearest marshal for advice.

It is your responsibility to tell us if you have any medical conditions.

St John Cymru Wales will have Medical Stations along the route as well as at the Start/Finish area.

Toilets

There'll be toilets at the Race Village in Festival Fields, as well as at various points along the route.

Brecon Carreg Water will be available along the route. There will also be energy gel stations. Please discard empty bottles and wrappers in the bins provided or to the side of the road/path and not along the course, where runners behind you could trip over them.

Massage

There will be a team of massage therapists from Gower College Swansea, located in the Race Village at Festival Fields, before and after the race.
